ORDER REGARDING AMENDED RULES

WHEREAS, Rule 1(e) of the Virgin Islands Rules of Appellate Procedure ["V.I.R.A.P."] states that the rules "supersede all previous appellate rules applicable to this Court" and that the Federal Rules of Appellate Procedure and the Local Appellate Rules of the United States Court of Appeals for the Third Circuit "no longer have any applicability to the Appellate Division of the District Court of the Virgin Islands," and

WHEREAS, Rule 1(e) also states that the V.I.R.A.P. governs "all proceedings pending at the time they take effect," it is hereby

ORDERED, that Rule 76.1 is **AMENDED** to read as follows:
Rule 76.1 [**Superseded by the Virgin Islands Rules of Appellate Procedure effective November 1, 1998**].
