GENERAL ORDER

GÓMEZ, J.

In any criminal matter in which the undersigned is the presiding judge, it is hereby

ORDERED that no more than 30 days after a defendant: (1) is found to be guilty by verdict; or (2) enters a guilty plea, the United States Attorney for the District of the Virgin Islands and the United States Probation Office for the District of the Virgin Islands shall provide to the Court a list of the victims who were harmed by the defendant's conduct; it is further

ORDERED that no more than 75 days after a defendant: (1) is found to be guilty by verdict; or (2) enters a guilty plea, the United States Attorney for the District of the Virgin Islands and the United States Probation Office for the District of the Virgin Islands shall provide to the Court and the defendant a report (the "restitution report"), which shall address, for each victim who was harmed by the defendant's conduct:

1. current and future costs of any necessary medical care and treatment for physical injuries suffered as a

- result of the defendant's actions;
2. current and future costs of any necessary psychiatric and psychological care and treatment for mental and emotional injuries suffered as a result of the defendant's actions;
 3. current and future transportation and related expenses incurred, and expected to be incurred, by the victim in obtaining any necessary medical care or treatment;
 4. if the victim is of an age to have employment, then any resulting current or future loss of income and current and future costs of any occupational therapy;
 5. the cost to repair or replace any property damaged, lost, or destroyed by the defendant's conduct;
 6. any pecuniary loss suffered as a result of the defendant's actions; and
 7. any other costs, harms, or expenses, current or anticipated, which were the result of the defendant's actions.

The monetary estimates shall be supported by appropriate substantiation and such substantiation shall be provided to the Court with the restitution report; it is further

ORDERED that the defendant shall file any response to the restitution report by no later than two weeks before the sentencing hearing; and it is further

ORDERED that the Clerk of Court shall deliver a copy of this general order to the United States Probation Office for the District of the Virgin Islands and the United States Attorney for the District of the Virgin Islands.
