THE DISTRICT COURT OF THE VIRGIN ISLANDS ISSUES FORTY-SIXTH ORDER CONCERNING OPERATIONS OF THE DISTRICT COURT OF THE VIRGIN ISLANDS VIDEO AND TELECONFERENCES FOR CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

The Honorable Robert A. Molloy, Chief Judge, issued the Forty-Sixth Order Concerning Operations of the District Court of the Virgin Islands Video and Teleconferences for Criminal Proceedings on Friday, March 31, 2023.

On March 27, 2020, Congress passed, and the President signed the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act ("CARES Act") authorizing the use of video conferencing and teleconferencing under certain circumstances and with the consent of the defendant after consultation with counsel for various events in criminal cases during the course of the COVID-19 emergency.

The most recent order extends the Forty-Fifth Order Concerning Operations of the District Court of the Virgin Islands Video and Teleconferences for Criminal Proceedings, entered on December 26, 2022. The order shall remain in effect for an additional 90 days from the March 31, 2023, unless terminated earlier or extended.
