**THE DISTRICT COURT OF THE VIRGIN ISLANDS ISSUES FOURTH  
ORDER CONCERNING OPERATIONS OF THE FEDERAL COURT  
DURING THE COVID-19 OUTBREAK**

The District Court of the Virgin Islands continues to monitor the outbreak of the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19). In so doing, the Honorable Wilma A. Lewis, Chief Judge, issued the Fourth Order Concerning Operations of the District Court of the Virgin Islands During COVID-19 Outbreak on Thursday, April 16, 2020.

The most recent order extends the Order Concerning Operations of the District Court of the Virgin Islands During the COVID-19 Outbreak entered on March 17, 2020 and the Second Order Concerning Operations of the District Court of the Virgin Islands During the COVID-19 Outbreak entered on March 20, 2020 through May 12, 2020.

The Third Order Concerning the Operations of the District Court of the Virgin Islands concerning Videoconferences and Teleconferences for Criminal Proceedings, entered on April 9, 2020 shall remain in effect for 90 days from the date of that Order, unless terminated earlier or extended.
