**THE DISTRICT COURT OF THE VIRGIN ISLANDS ISSUES SEVENTH ORDER
CONCERNING OPERATIONS OF THE DISTRICT COURT OF THE VIRGIN ISLANDS
DURING THE COVID-19 OUTBREAK**

The District Court of the Virgin Islands continues to monitor the outbreak of the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19). In so doing, the Honorable Wilma A. Lewis, Chief Judge, issued the Seventh Order Concerning Operations of the District Court of the Virgin Islands During COVID-19 Outbreak on Friday, June 12, 2020.

The most recent order extends the Sixth Order Concerning Operations of the District Court of the Virgin Islands During the COVID-19 Outbreak entered on May 12, 2020, which is set to expire on June 16, 2020. The Order shall be extended and continue in full force and effect through July 15, 2020, except that Court personnel will return to work at the Federal Courthouses effective June 15, 2020. No in-person services will be provided pending further Order of the Court.
