ORDER CONCERNING OPERATIONS OF THE DISTRICT COURT OF

The District Court of the Virgin Islands continues to monitor the outbreak of the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19). In so doing, the Honorable Wilma A. Lewis, Chief Judge, issued the Sixth Order Concerning Operations of the District Court of the Virgin Islands During COVID-19 Outbreak on Tuesday, May 12, 2020.

The most recent order extends the Fourth Order Concerning Operations of the District Court of the Virgin Islands during the COVID-19 Outbreak entered on April 16, 2020, which is set to expire on May 13, 2020. The Order shall be extended and continue in full force and effect through June 15, 2020, unless terminated earlier or extend.
