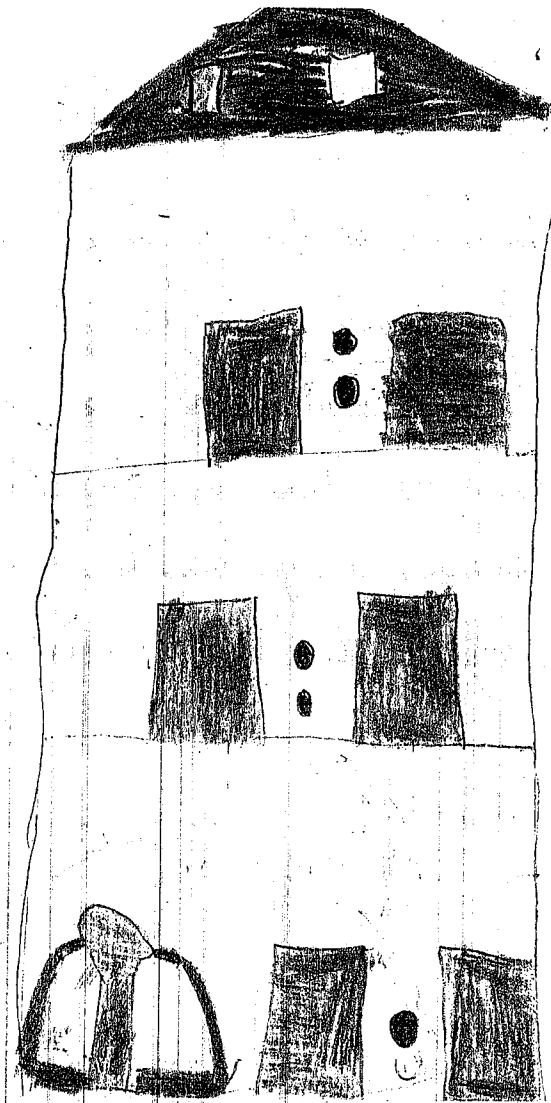


Dear Judge Gomez,

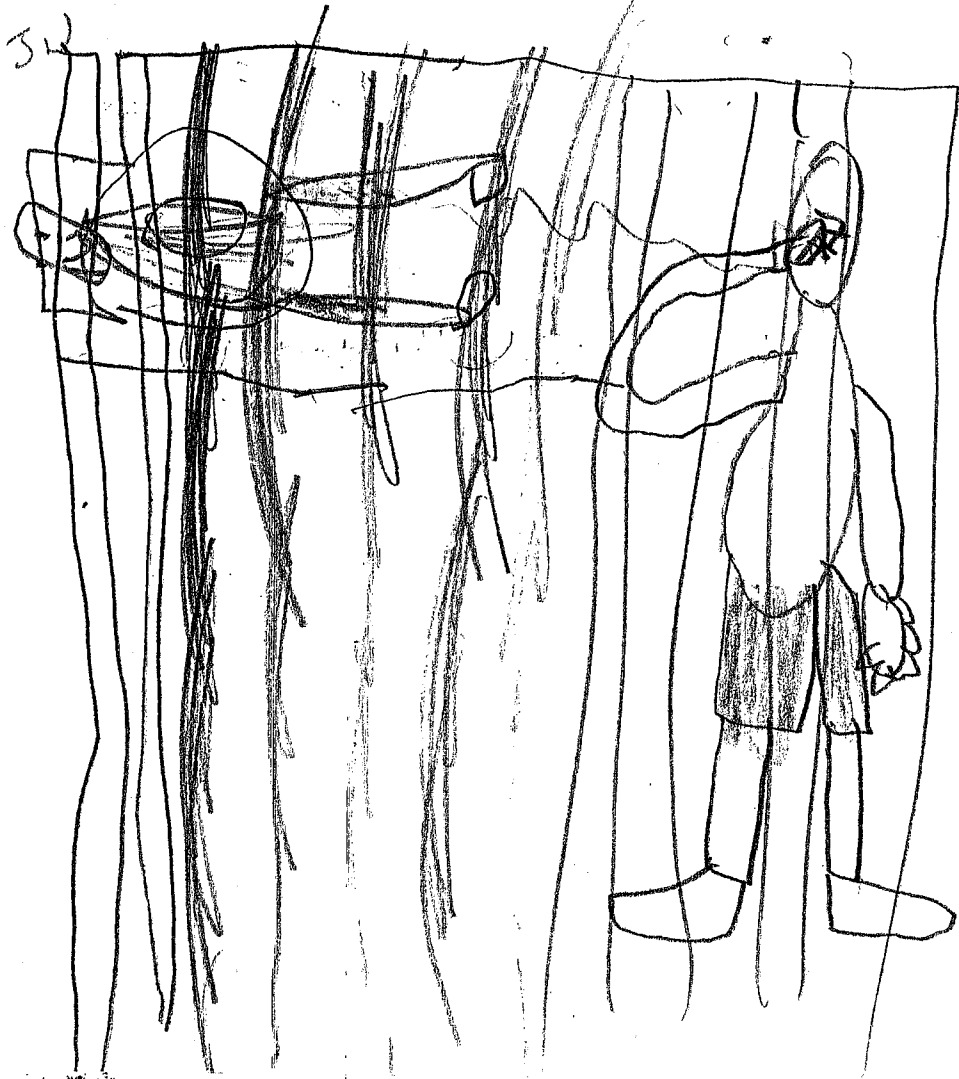
Dear Judge Gomez,

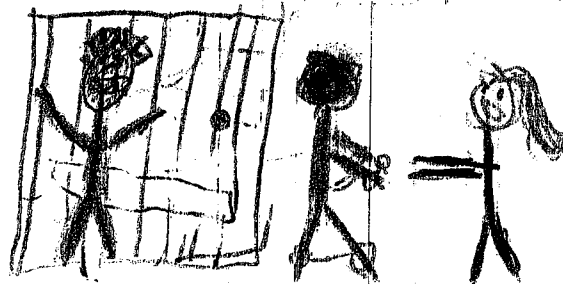
Dear Judge Gomey,
